

Rope Level 1 (32 Hours)

Course Pre-requisites

- Students MUST be 18 years of age.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Introduction to Technical Rescue Module 1 and Module 2* programs.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or public safety agency/department to apply to attend.
- Students shall be psychologically, physically, and medically capable to perform assigned duties and functions at technical search and rescue incidents and to perform training exercises in accordance with of NFPA 1500 *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Program*, Chapter 10-Medical and Physical Requirements.

Vehicle Level 1 (16 Hours)

Course Pre-requisites

- Students MUST be 18 years of age.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Introduction to Technical Rescue Module 1 and Module 2* programs.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or public safety agency/department to apply to attend.

Trench Level I (16 Hours)

- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Rope Rescue Level I (Operations Level)* program.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Confined Space Rescue Level I (Operations Level)* program.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or emergency services agency/department to apply to attend.
- Students shall be psychologically, physically, and medically capable to perform assigned duties and functions at technical search and rescue incidents and to perform training exercises in accordance with of NFPA 1500 *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Program*, Chapter 10-Medical and Physical Requirements.

Trench Level II (24 Hours)

Course Pre-requisites

- Students MUST be 18 years of age.

- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Confined Space Rescue Level II* program.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Vehicle Rescue Level II* program.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or emergency services agency/department to apply to attend.
- Students shall be psychologically, physically, and medically capable to perform assigned duties and functions at technical search and rescue incidents and to perform training exercises in accordance with of NFPA 1500 *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Program*, Chapter 10-Medical and Physical Requirements.

Machinery Rescue (8 Hours)

Course Pre-requisites:

- Student MUST be 18 years of age on the first day of class.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or public safety agency/department to apply to attend.
- Student shall be psychologically, physically, and medically capable to perform assigned duties and functions at technical search and rescue incidents and to perform training exercises in accordance with NFPA 1500 *Standard on Fire Department Occupational Safety and Health Programs*, Chapter 10 – Medical and Physical Requirements.
- Completion of VDFP recognized Hazardous Material Operations course.

Emergency Building Shoring (16 Hours)

Course Pre-requisites:

- Students MUST be 18 years of age.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Rope Rescue Level I* program.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Confined Space Rescue Level I* program.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Vehicle Rescue Level I* program.
- Successful completion of Virginia Department of Fire Programs *Trench Rescue Level I* program.
- Students must be a member in good standing with a recognized fire, EMS, or emergency services agency/department to apply to attend.
